Analyse

To examine something in detail to understand it fully

Balcony

The raised seating towards the back of a theatre

Circle/dress circle/upper circle The tiers of raised seating in a theatre

Climate change

Long-term shift in the planet's weather patterns and average temperatures

Commission/sales commission

The money the theatre earns based on how much merchandise it sells

Data sheet

A record of all of the information about each object in a museum or gallery's collection

Delegate To assign tasks to different people

Evaluate To assess the success or effectiveness of something

Front-of-house The part of a venue that is open to the public

Genre The style or category of art, music or literature

Leeds

Matinee An afternoon or daytime performance

Merchandise or 'merch'

Items on sale that are linked to a production (e.g. branded clothing and accessories)

Producer

The person responsible for the management and finance of a production

Production Any form of theatre, including a ballet or opera

Prologue Introduction

Property or prop An item used within a production

Prototype An early sample or model of something

Running list The order of scenes in a production

Stalls

The first level of seating directly in front of the stage

Stock

The type and number of items available for sale (e.g. drinks and ice cream)

Synopsis

A summary of a production, film or book
